God is Just

Bible Story: God Confronts the Sin of Belshazzar Daniel 4:1-6

King Belshazzar was aware of the one true God who had revealed Himself to King Nebuchadnezzar and knew better to sin against God, yet he choose to do so.

Think about it: What happens when you choose to sin after believing in Jesus? Does that mean you aren't saved anymore? No. But your sin is still serious to God. God doesn't love you less, but your sin can hurt your friendship with God. God tells you what to do when you realize you have been sinning. You should tell God about your sin and that you are sorry for it. Then remember that He forgives your sin and makes you clean from all bad things you do.

Draw and color a heart to remind you God doesn't stop loving you when you sin.

Memory verse can you say it without looking:

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

To help your child remember the verse make flash cards. You will need 16 cards total to write each word on its own card. Then have your child read it over and over again, but each time removing a card till there is none.
