During a Daniel Fast you may eat fruits, vegetables, beans, lentils, salads; drink water and juices, avoid breads, pastas, sodas, meats, caffeine, junk foods, and TV.

Daily Scriptures:

Sun. April 5th- Magnifying God’s Faithfulness

Genesis 9:16(NLT)

When I see the rainbow in the clouds, I will remember the eternal covenant between God and every living creature on earth.

Psalms 105: 8(NLT)

He always stands by His covenant the commitment He made to a thousand generations. *(God keeps His word throughout the generations, He will keep His word to you.)*

Mon. April 6th- Praising God for His Forgiveness

Ephesians 1:7(NLT)

He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins.

Hebrews 10:2-24, & 13:20-21 (NLT)

(By His death, Jesus opened a new and life-giving way through the curtain into the Most Holy Place. And since we have a great High Priest who rules over God’s house, let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting him.

For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ’s blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water. Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works.)

Tues. April 7th- Thanking God for His Faithful love

Isaiah 54:9-10(NLT)

Just as I swore in the time of Noah that I will never again let a flood cover the earth, so now I swear that I will never again be angry and punish you. For the mountains may move and the hills disappear but even then, my faithful love for you will remain

The Covenant that our Lord made through Jesus is unilateral meaning It is God ordained, God sustained, and God maintained.
(Genesis 15:4-21 & 17:17)

God has established an all-embracing binding covenant relationship of eternal blessings through the Lord Jesus on our behalf.
(Luke 22:7-21)
